Include both New messages and Replies/forward signatures. Type in Name, Job Class, Work Location, Contact info (i.e. e-mail, phone, etc.) in whatever font or style you like. – OK.

CUPE 5678 and Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario (STEO)

What is CUPE 5678-1?

This represents the staff from Student Transportation of Eastern Ontario (STEO), who are CUPE members.

STEO formed over 9 years ago due to a mandate of the Ontario Ministry of Education, called Student Transportation Reform. Transportation Consortia were created among coterminous school boards to jointly manage and plan student transportation.

The transportation employees from CUPE Local 4154 – Catholic District School Board of Eastern Ontario and CUPE Local 5678 – Upper Canada District School Board came together in one local.

This was a stressful time for these employees. Although both groups did the same work, both locals had different collective agreements, job classifications, job descriptions and wage grids. On top of that, a new office location had yet to be determined.

At that time, our CUPE National Representative and the Presidents from both Locals were conducive in achieving the first collective agreement for these members.

These members job classifications include:

- Accounting Assistant
- GIS Administrator
- Transportation Clerk/Receptionist
- Special Needs Transportation Route Planner
- Transportation Route Planner
- Transportation Team Lead
