Did you know that our collective agreements expire at the end of August 2026? That means it is time to gear up for the next round of bargaining. We need to show the employer and the province that we are in this together.

OSBCU (Ontario School Board Council of Unions) has released Nancy Ripley to work with our local to help mobilize our members. She will be assisting with many things throughout her release time.

We have a new position (replacing communicators) starting this year. They are called CATS for **C**ommunication **A**ction **T**eam. We are looking for many people for these positions. The goal of the CAT is to assist in getting information to our members as quickly as possible. If you are interested in this position, please reach out and we will get you the information. More hands make less work.

The new Attendance Support Program has been rolled out. This only includes medical and sick leave. Each case will be reviewed on an individual basis. Please reach out if you are notified that you are becoming part of this program. The union should attend these meetings with you.

Emergency workers (non-qualified) will only be used on an emergency basis. If this is not the case in your school, we the union need to know so we can address it asap.

We will be meeting soon with STEO to develop a bargaining survey. Stay tuned for its release.

Remember all CUPE members are to read and sign the safety plans and if there is a student that is being a bit off remember to fill out the **On-Line Incident Reports,** it is awful you must fill them out, but we are seeing them and if you would like someone to come to your site for a visit please Reach out!

We are here to help you and make your day transition smoothly. If the safety plan says to wear PPE, then you must wear the PPE not just when the child is escalating unless that is written in the safety plan.

If you ordered and received an agenda, there is a user-Friendly page on when to complete the Online Reporting form or KICs in some case you may have to fill out both forms. If you feel you need to fill out either of these forms, it is your Right, and you do not need your Administrators' permission to complete them. If you are required to complete your Parklane at the end of your shift, please ask your Administrators if you go over your scheduled departure time if you can put in for Overtime or LIEU hours.

These online reports are not to be completed on your own time or during your lunch break they are to be completed during your scheduled work time.

Workplace Safety

CUPE education workers in Ontario are also part of the Ontario School Board Council of Unions (OSBCU), which unites 57,000 CUPE education workers in the public, Catholic, English and French school systems across the province.

In November 2024, over 12,000 education workers across Ontario completed the OSBCU's services survey. The results were astounding and provided a clear picture of how the crisis in underfunding and understaffing in public education has created widespread violence, burnout and lack of supports for staff and students.
